The project was to modernize the new office space of Tuango, a Montreal based company, located on the ground floor of the prestigious Affiliated Building, in Old Montreal. Faced with rapid expansion, Tuango needed a space that they could grow in to, finally settling on close to 3850 sq.ft - a space with room to grow and lots of character.

The idea behind the whole concept was the 3-dimensions materialization of the Tuango logo, which is displayed prominently on 10-foot glass cube at the entrance of the space. Tuango's business is centered around group buying and promotions, and the central cube is a physical representation of this - a space for group collaboration. The cube also serves as "external" signage, with the large logo being visible from the street, as the company was not allowed any true external signage on the building. Other highlights

include an open work space, board room, several closed offices, kitchen and lounge area. In order to emphasize the natural light coming from the many windows, the walls and the open ceiling were painted white. In keeping with the spirit of an Old Montreal "loft", a natural maple wood floor was chosen.

Composition of the cube: the walls are in glass with an orange tinted film applied on it, the ceiling is an acrylic material with a lacquered finished, accentuating the effect of size with its reflection, the custom made steel table conference table was painted in their trademark color, translucent chairs recall the transparency of the cube.
